## Ten years tough

Swiftel Center kicks off annual Tough Enough to Wear Pink campaign starting October 1

(09/30/2015) – The Swiftel Center’s annual Tough Enough to Wear Pink campaign kicks off its 10th year on Thursday, October 1. T-shirts will be available for purchase starting at 9:00 a.m. Proceeds from t-shirt sales will be donated to the Brookings Health System Foundation to support the fight against cancer.

The Swiftel Center is launching this year’s campaign in bold pink color to commemorate the anniversary year. The 2015 design features bold lettering on a hot pink t-shirt.

T-shirts will be available for purchase at the Swiftel Center Box Office, Monday through Friday 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Other purchasing locations include Avera Brookings Medical Clinic, South Dakota State University Wellness Center and Brookings Health System’s hospital. T-shirts are \$10.00 (\$12.00 for 2XL or 3XL). Adult and youth sizing available. This October, the Brookings community is once again challenged to think pink. Businesses are asked to designate one day a week as “Think Pink” day on which employees can wear the Tough Enough to Wear Pink t-shirts. Photos will be shared on Swiftel Center’s social networks.

Funds raised by the 2015 Tough Enough to Wear Pink campaign will be used locally to promote cancer screening benefits, such as regular mammograms. Funds will also help provide specialized cancer education and training to local cancer care teams at Avera Medical Clinic in Brookings and Brookings Health System. Lastly, campaign funds will be used to provide financial assistance to patients in need. Available funds can be applied to the cost of mammograms performed at Avera Medical Clinic in Brookings; breast biopsies, ultrasounds, lymphedema therapy, mastectomies and reconstruction performed at Brookings Health System; or post-mastectomy products from Brookings Health System-Avera Home Medical Equipment store.

More than \$41,000 has been raised to-date through the annual Tough Enough to Wear Pink campaign. The Swiftel Center works with Brookings Health System Foundation to effectively distribute funds. Thanks to community support, the Tough Enough to Wear Pink campaign has assisted many cancer patients in Brookings County with 100% of proceeds staying local.
